## **Nettleton wins Terang 300 metres**

Darryl Nettleton has broken through for a win at the latest Victorian Athletic League professional meet held at Terang.

Nettleton running from the 39 metre mark, won the Combined Womens/Veterans 300 metres by 1/100<sup>th</sup> second over Terry McGarity, with a time of 36.88 seconds.

George Flack, running from the 380 metre mark, ran 4.20.92 for second place in the Open 1600 metres.

Glenn Stephens made it through to the Terang Gift 120 metre Final, finishing in 5<sup>th</sup> place. Stephens also finished 4<sup>th</sup> in the 70 metre Final.

Dujon Fuzzard made the Semi Finals of the 70 metres and was 3<sup>rd</sup> in his heat of the 400 metres.

Victorian Athletic League action moves to Princes Park Carlton this Thursday, when the Melbourne Gift will be contested.

8 athletes from Bendigo have entered in the carnival which starts at 6.30pm.

62 athletes in total have entered the Tabcorp Open 1600 metres, with Backmarker Brady Threlfall running off the 60 metre mark, Josh Nolan from 110m, Phil Noden 145m & Greg Hilson 220m.

In the Tabcorp Womens 400 metres, Caitlyn Hocking will race from 36m & Kirrily Burnett from 46 metres.

Sean Ryan will run in the AWD 120 metre Gift from the 26 metre mark.

In the Veterans 300 metres, Stawell finalist Greg Hilson will race from 27 metres with Steve Campbell coming off the 60 metre handicap.

On Sunday, runners will head to Frankston for the Peninsula Gift.

Glenn Stephens will contest the Peninsula 120m Gift from the 13.75m mark, as well as the 70 metres off 7.75m.

Greg Hilson will run from 27m in the Veterans 300m, with Darryl Nettleton scheduled to run from 39m, but will cop a penalty for his Terang win.

Caitlyn Hocking will run the Novice 400 metres, plus the Womens 400 metres from the 36m mark.

Kirrily Burnett will also contest the Womens 400 from 42 metres.

Michael Tuhan & George Flack will do battle in both the 800 metres and 1600 metres events. Tuhan will race off 44m & 145m, whilst Flack has 156m & 380m respectively!

Glenn Stephens 30m, Greg Hilson 42m & Darryl Nettleton 62m will face off in the Open 400 metres.

Action at Frankston Park commences from 12.30pm.
